Patty Hart Memorial Scholarship Application Information

History: Patty Hart was a dedicated and hardworking member of the GFWC Danville Women's Club for 30 years (1968-1998). Ms. Hart worked on many committees, fundraisers and club activities. She was the Club's President from 1983-84 and the Education Committee Chairman from 1984-1998. In her role as Education Committee Chairman, Ms. Hart was an advocate for providing educational opportunities to all students and was a firm believer that there was more to being a good student than top grades. Intangibles, like school spirit, community awareness and service as well as responsibilities outside the classroom were important indicators of a student's character and integrity. The Patty Hart Memorial Scholarship was created to celebrate and honor Ms. Hart's tireless work for the Danville Women's Club and her passion for education.

Award: The GFWC Danville Women's Club is offering a \$1,000 scholarship to a graduating senior from each high school in the San Ramon Valley Unified School District.

Objective: To recognize and award a senior student who has shown leadership qualities and has demonstrated a strong work ethic in their academic studies, school activities, community service and employment experience.

Criteria:

- Full time enrollment (12 units or more per semester) in an accredited junior college or four-year college/university.
- High School GPA of 2.75-4.0 and above.

Procedure: Applicants should complete and submit the Scholarship Application Form to danvillewc@gmail.com or **Danville Women's Club, P.O. Box 564, Danville, CA 94526** by **Friday, March 22, 2020**. Three finalists will be chosen by the Club's Education Committee for interviews and notified by **April 6, 2020**. Interviews will be scheduled through the high school's College and Career Center, beginning the week of **April 6, 2020**. The Scholarship Recipient will be notified by **April 20, 2020** and is invited, along with their parents and school counselors, as guests of honor to a Scholarship Awards Luncheon hosted by GFWC Danville Women's Club on **Thursday, May 21, 2020**. It is the hope of all Club members that the Scholarship Recipient will plan to attend the Scholarship Luncheon.
